


Salvias are pollinated by hummingbirds, bumblebees, wasps, and bees. Hummingbirds will defend the sages in their territory like they are the only water source in the desert! Sages are extremely drought tolerant, can live for 30 years or more, and are often

considered a favorite garden plant.


